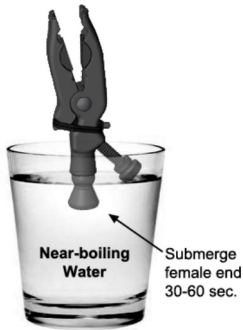


# Re-attaching the clip

To re-attach the clip, forcefully press it onto the segment that it was previously attached to. It should snap into place with an audible "pop". It takes a substantial amount of pressure to make this happen.

If you are having difficulty you can heat up the female socket to facilitate the process

**Plamp Thumbscrew Clip Tension Adjust Key**

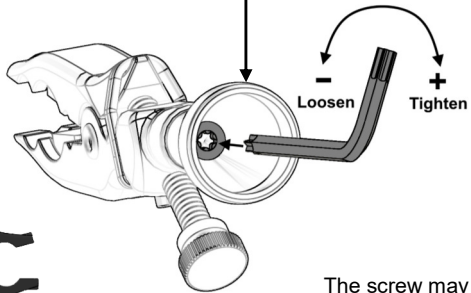
## Adjusting the rotational resistance of the clip

The Plamp clip is designed to rotate relative to the articulating arm with slightly less resistance than is found between similar arm segments.

If you desire this resistance to be higher or lower, you may accomplish this by adjusting the Torx 20 mounting screw clockwise (for more resistance) or counter-clockwise (for less resistance)



You may access this screw by popping off the final arm segment and plamp clip from the arm.



The screw may also be adjusted with a Torx 20 driver
